MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND CLASSES RULES AND REGULATIONS

CLASS 'A' RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREED PONIES 4 YEARS OLD & OVER

- Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B . Stallion, Mare or Gelding.
- Riders any age, except for small breed stallions, rider must be 12 years or over at the 1st January of the current year.

CLASS 'B' RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREED PONIES 4 YEARS OLD & OVER

- Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D. stallion, Mare or gelding.
- Riders any age, except for large Breed stallions, rider must be 14 years or over at the 1st January of the current year.

ATTIRE & EQUIPMENT :

- **Hats** – Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards **MUST** be worn by all Riders. All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; Snell E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The EN1384, BSEN1384 may also be worn until 1 January 2017, unless otherwise notified.
- **Jackets** – it is recommended that riders of Mountain & Moorland Ponies wear tweed jackets.
- **Whips/canes** must not exceed an overall length of 76cms (30 inches).
- **No Spurs**

BRIDLES & BITS:

- **Ponies may be shown in any suitable Bridle.**
- The judge should take into account the suitability of the bridle & bit, based on the rider's competence and the way the pony is going in the class.
- Flash & dropped nosebands are to be discouraged in flat ridden classes.
